## What information do we collect?

We will hold your name and email address in a secure database with MailChimp.

- This information is collected when you apply for the Free Demo or become a customer of DrumtracksbyJulian.com
- Using the form, your name and email address will be captured. This will be entered into our MailChimp database
- This information will also be captured if you become a customer and you have not previously requested a Free Demo.

## How do we use personal information?

We will use your name and email address to keep in touch with you. This may include:

- Survey of your experience of the Free Demo
- Survey of your experience of a completed drum track project
- Marketing communications for such things as seasonal discounts and offers
- Send you the link to your Free Demo
- Send you the link to your Completed Drum Track(s)
